The use of the community league parking lot is a privilege that should be respected. If the community league requires the use of their parking lot for community programs or events, please use the available on-street parking.

Parking Lot Expectations

1. Drop-off and pick-up includes stopping and parking vehicles. Vehicles should be parked for approximately 5 minutes.
2. Visitor day passes are available upon request for school visitors and volunteers from the community
3. When the community league requires the parking lot for community events signage will be posted at the parking lot entrance.
4. Information regarding the community league events and community programs will be shared on SchoolZone.
5. The paved tarmac area will not be used by vehicles during school hours, 8 AM to 4 PM.
6. No parking in front of garbage bins.
